Overview

The objective of the OTHM Extended Diploma in Logistics and Supply Chain Management qualification is to provide learners with a specialist program of study that provides a depth of knowledge and understanding of key aspects within the Logistics and Supply Chain Management sector.

Learners will study level 4 and 5 units, worth 120 credits per academic year with a total credit value of 240 credits (equivalent to the first 2 years of an honors degree).
